

JUR MISSION STATEMENT To perform music that motivates and inspires our communities toward justice, diversity and equality as we strive for peace and build our web of mutuality.

The World House Choir is a diverse, multi-cultural, mixed-voice community choir whose repertoire is drawn from different traditions including classical, global folk music, spirituals, gospel, and the music of peace and justice struggles worldwide.

The World House Choir performed our first concert on the occasion of Coretta Scott King's birthday, April 27, 2013 and we continue to appear in programs across Southwest Ohio. Our self-produced concerts include

- Love Makes a Family: A Pep Rally for Marriage Equality [Oct 2014]
- Missa Gaia: A Celebration of Mother Earth [Sept 2015]
- Come Sit at the Welcome Table, [Sept 2016] a program about harboring our world family of refugees and immigrants.

We regularly perform for Martin Luther King Day programs and sing at colleges and universities in the area (Antioch College, Wilmington College, Urbana University). We've sung at the House of Joy in Cincinnati, Central Chapel AME in Yellow Springs, and Grace United Methodist in Dayton. We've sung at TED-X Dayton and share concert programs at Madison Correctional, Dayton Correctional, Warren Correctional, and Marion Correctional. We recently performed for Black History Month program at Wright Patterson Air Force Base, Fairborn, Ohio.

Dr. Catherine Roma, founding artistic director of the World House Choir, is well known in Cincinnati and the surrounding tri-state area. She taught at Wilmington College for 25 years, founded and conducted MUSE Cincinnati's Women's Choir for 30 years, was Minister of Music at St. John's Unitarian Universalist Church for 29 years, and currently conducts choirs in several area prisons. Roma also co-founded and co-directed the Martin Luther King Chorale for 22 years (with Bishop Todd O'Neal) and worked extensively with the Indian Community in musical productions (with Kanniks Kannikeswaren).
